CONDUCT RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR VISITORS AND CONTRACTORS TO CARIS VRD

- 1) Visitors must not, under any circumstances, access any areas they are not authorised to enter.
- 2) Visitors must be accompanied at all times when moving around the company premises.
- 3) Visitors are obliged to observe and comply with any safety related signs (dangers, prohibitions, obligations) and any company requirements in force regarding the wearing of Personal Protective Equipment at the facility.
- 4) Visitors must remain fully aware of any moving traffic such as forklift trucks or other vehicles. Wherever possible, the designated pedestrian walkways (indicated by horizontal markings) should be used.
- 5) For safety reasons, it is forbidden to touch (unless authorised) any substances, machines, equipment or products.
- 6) Visitors must take note of the facility's escape routes and emergency exits; this information can be found on the specific emergency plans posted on noticeboards. In the event of an emergency, if there is a need for all personnel to evacuate the facility, this will be indicated by a constant sounding of the dedicated alarms. To reach a safe location / assembly point, visitors must follow safety signs and signs indicating the direction of the escape routes.
